

To whom it may concern,

As from 1st October 2016 we are updating our booking in system at Ashley Chase Estate LTD for all vehicles exceeding 7.5T. Please see attached PDF which clearly shows the route for all vehicles which exceed 7.5T.

Due to our location in a remote village we find ourselves restricted with narrow lanes, so bearing this in mind please <u>notify drivers not to use Sat Nav.</u> We hope this system will be beneficial not only to the local community but to all drivers as we hope this would avoid vehicles attempting to pass each other in the rural lanes.

Drivers are requested to exercise great care on the lanes which are much used by pedestrians and cyclists. In addition, please note that the verges to the lanes and village street are extremely vulnerable and therefore try to avoid damage to the verges and streets where possible. It is most important that you recognise that Ashley Chase is serviced by narrow country lanes and you should seriously consider employing small HGV's wherever possible.

Booking in system:

Please contact us on 01308 482580 and book in all deliveries with Claire Churchill (Receptionist) or alternatively you can e-mail clairec@fordfarm.com and book in. In her absence please book in deliveries with Reception.

We hope this system will be beneficial not only to the local community but to all drivers, as we hope this will avoid vehicles attempting to pass each other in the narrow country lanes. Please could you ensure that all drivers are alert and considerate to other road users such as cyclists, pedestrians and school children in this typically quiet village environment.

Collections & deliveries will be accepted between the hours of 7.30am - 3.30pm on weekdays other than Bank Holidays.

If your vehicle is not booked in with us we reserve the right to refuse the delivery/collection. Where possible we must ask that you use a vehicle proportionate to the goods you are collecting/delivering from us. If you are employing a 3rd party to make deliveries or collections please ensure that this information is passed on to the relevant party.





Directions for large goods vehicles:

From the West:

Turn right at the end of the second dual carriageway after leaving Bridport on the A35, at the bottom of a hill with a sign post to Long Bredy, Litton Cheney and Puncknowle – this is Long Bredy Hut Lane.

From the East:

Take the second left three and a half miles after leaving Winterbourne Abbas on the A35, at the beginning of a dual carriageway with a sign post to Long Bredy, Litton Cheney and Puncknowle - this is Long Bredy Hut Lane.

Go to the bottom of the hill and turn LEFT signed to Long Bredy (NOT Litton Cheney).

Follow the road through the village of Long Bredy (ignoring signposts to Dorchester and the No Through Road) and take the fourth turning on your left which will be after you have left the village and when you see a sign pointing left to Parks Farm.

Follow the sign, over the small bridge, to the top of the hill ignoring the turning to the left.

You will then see the dairy at the bottom of the hill on your right hand side.

If your driver is unsure, please ask them to contact us on 01308 482580, and do please remind them **not to use their sat nav**; We are happy to offer additional guidance into the factory.
